Vanderpot uses old "fossil" walrus ivory excavated by Alaskan Eskimos on St. Lawrence Island in the Bering Sea.



The ivory ranges between 100 and 2000 years old. The variegated patina is the result of the absorption of minerals and pigments over time, giving each piece its unique quality.
